

Ekonomski škola Požega sudjelovala je u međunarodnom eTwinning projektu *Let's Share and Learn*.

Ciljevi projekta bili su:


- razmjena znanja i iskustava među učenicima, ali i nastavnicima tijekom pandemije
- upoznavanje novih ljudi

- uključivanje učenika u aktivnosti koje će ih potaći na učenje i dijeljenje ideja

U projekt je bilo uključeno dvadeset nastavnika i više od pedeset učenika iz 7 država – Turske, Rumunjske, Poljske, Hrvatske, Jordana, Grčke i Armenije.



Radni jezik projekta bio je engleski, a u sklopu projekta sudjelovali smo u online sastancima, pisali i slali tradicionalna pisma i e-mailove, izrađivali plakate, prezentacije, kvizove i slično.

Učenici i nastavnici koristili su brojne digitalne alate i to: Google Meet, Zoom, Powerpoint, Flipgram, Prezi, Slide share, Kahoot, Padlet, Canva, Lucidchart i druge.




Projektne aktivnosti odvijale su se prema unaprijed određenom planu i zaduženjima.








Croatian history

- two Roman provinces: Pannonia and Dalmatia
- in the 7th century - the Duchy of Croatia
- the Kingdom of Croatia – 925-1918
- in the 12th century the Kingdom of Croatia entered a Personal Union with the Kingdom of Hungary
- after the First World War - breakup of the Habsburg Monarchy, incorporation into Yugoslavia
- in the Second World War - independent Croatian state
- after the Second World War – a part of Yugoslavia
- independence in 1991 - the dissolution of Yugoslavia – War for independence


